<p>13. Project Description:</p>	<p>In the joint action of EDC Nepal and DCA Nepal PAHUCH Project was launched at Two palika KI Singh RM and Sikhar Municipality 9 wards of Doti district. In this wards no other developments orgnasation work at sector of women empowerment and developments.. Most of the people of community are illiterate most of them from dalit women. They have not knowledge of law and order of country including nearest governments unit wards office and palika judicial commite. LG and Province Governments detail workout of their program, policy and budget for upcoming fiscal year for developments . KI Singh palika of Doti carry new program President with dalit and vice president with women and palika also developed as refral guideline in technical support of EDC Action Aid support and also set up Safe house at palika .In reporting period according to the district policy information officer 7 cases of multimarriage ,20 cases of GBV and 6 cases of caste base discrimination and 9 cases of rape and 4 cases of child marriage was registred . Similarly both palika of coverage area judicial comitee have registred 46 cases related to GBV out of that 18 were resolved . Both palika also establish GBV fund including formed GBV fund operation guide line. Economic and social condition of coverage area people slightly change than previous. Due to two years ago when the PAHUCH project run diffrent awareness activities at such as Chalfal Chautari ,interaction among GBV cases with community key person and palika LGs representative and aware in women group especially caste base discrimination and GBV and its legal provision diffrent GBV case was coming at group level and it become awareness on moving to the palika judicial comitee increased day by day.</p> <p>Climate change issue is new among right holders and stakeholders and less common concern about it . Its rapaidly hamper day by day rapidly but community have not response mitigation measure .Coverage area people suffer from its effect such as agricultural and environmental sector which was also in their regular activities. Due to of the discussion on Chalfal Chautari, wall paintings and school awareness program, women group member and students know about its basic concept and its effects on multipliers sector and also apply its mitigation measures. In presents also community eliot groups capture the resource from LGs and concern authority marginalised have less chance to accessing resources .So slightly diffrent intervention of project aware them about process on palika resources such as different project submit at CAP and budget and policy of palika etc. Different project formed groups and aware on social issue such as caste system ,chaupadi and early marriage. They conducted door to door campaign about these issues which was embracing most powerful role to minimize issue. Coverage area people suffer from effect of climate change such as agricultural and environmental sector which was also in their regular activities. Chalfal Chautari Wall paintings and school awareness program women group member know about its basic concept and its effects on multipliers sector and also apply its mitigation measures. The project has been contributing in line with the pathways developed for the TOC under the theme- Fight Extreme Inequality. The also support to new CPD of DCA which clearly spells out the focus on climate issues, digital literacy, GBV and leadership development of women, Dalit and other marginalised communities.</p>

Output 1: Enhanced knowledge and awareness of right holders and duty bearers on climate

1.1.1: Identify and orient champions on climate issues :

One refresher training were completed at the reporting period on the participation of 12 youth Climate Champion of PAHUCH Coverage area Shikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM. The training were focused on climate change issue and its adaptation and mitigation measure at local level. The training contribute enhance knowledge and understandings of participants' to design community women group . Anita Tamrakar BK local Climate Champion of Shikhar Municipality Doti one of the participants said I was know effect of climate change boon to me the skill how to cope with climate change effects and also orient to local women group confidently including school level orientation programme at coverage area.

1.1.2: Orientation to Group members at group level (Experience sharing):

40 Group level experience sharing meeting was complete at PAHUCH coverage area Shikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM Doti. Including participants of 344 Dalit women 21 other women

- Sharing information about climate change issue its mitigation ,adaptation measure at local level.
- It helps to increase capacity of group member about climate and right base issue.
- It helps to develop the confidence to deliver speech to remote women at huge mass including developing leadership.
- It helps to learning experience about each group to project conducted activities.

1.1.4: Orientation by champion at group level : Gather and understand the basic fundamental theme of climate change then organise orientation to the selected lead champion. The trained leader champion will conduct group orientation on project women group including sensitization on school awareness events ,wall paintings and identify the committed person in the group to as community climate champion at local level .They oriented 40 women group of PAHUCH project under Shikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM Doti. 128 dalit female other female 160 other female total 288 group member orient on climate change issue including its adaptation and mitigation issue.

1.1.5: School level awareness activities: School level awareness activities were conducted at reporting period at the presence of 535 students of both palika. In these events they share knowledge on climate change and its effects including mitigation by the means of essay and drawing competition.

- Working area 10 schools dug out separate soil pit to collect plastic and nonplastic waste at their school after orientation.
- 7 school of coverage area decide annual tree plantation campaign at upcoming monsoon at fix at their annual education calendar .
- Out of 535 , 250 students curious about it and told to their parents at home about climate adaptation method at individual level.

1.2.1: Day celebration (Climate change and Environment Day):

Different Day Celebration has conducted with collaboration of women networks. EDC will organise the different events on the occasion of Environment Day and International Day against caste discrimination and International Women Day including menstrual hygiene day. Day celebration campaign at local level including rally ,plantation,submitting concern letter including joint venture programme of local stakeholder at local level. In total 735 people of both palika aware on issue of Caste base discrimination and its legal provision including GBV

and environmental issue. Well coordination and collaboration with different district and palika level stakeholders.

At their new policy and programme after submitting concern letter from women group. GBV and CBD issue was discussed on grassroot level. KI Singh RM 3 group member Paru Bhul registered GBV cases on their husbands at palika level judicial committee. Women group member carried out different GBV related issues face on individual level and discuss on group level. Women group women conscious about present legal provision of GBV and CBD.

In the occasion of international women Day at the initiation of PAHUCH project coverage both palika women group deliver concern letter to palika sincere about climate change issue. After it KI Singh RM Doti banned flashed print on their palika at the formal occasion of different project and programme launched on palika.

1.2.2: Radio program on the issues of Climate Change/GBV/local governance/Access to resources:

1800 events of radio gingle was broadcast by two different media of Doti district at reporting period. It enhanced the knowledge skill aware on different issue such as climate change, gender based violence, caste base discrimination and other social stigma which was prevalent in our community. Radio Gingle dialogue programme has carried out on daily 5 times include monthly 150 times broadcast awareness on different issue monthly from local FM of Doti. Existing social issues such as climate change, GBV, meaningful participation of women in political leadership and CBD etc will be the major part of the program. Radio program will be aired in both working area. It enhanced the knowledge skill aware on different theme knowledge on issue such as climate change, gender based violence, caste base discrimination and other social stigma which was prevalent in our community. In reporting period total 1800 times broadcast gingle on above mentioned issue. By the means of radio gingle project area including radio coverage area citizen informed about different issue.

1.3 Chhalfal Chautari on various social issue such as climate Change, socio-economic package, GBV, Untouchability, and many more:

Collect issues of targets groups and priorities them to bring it in CHHALFAL CHAUTARI. Gather the Concern stakeholders together and discuss on the issues of climate change, socio-economic, GBV, untouchability and service providing scheme including receiving process of LGs at community level. The group network leads the program in the helps of SM at local level. At least one Chhalfal Chautari will conduct each month on the different burning issues which may be related to inclusion of marginalized women participation in political parties, impact of climate change in livelihood of people, local resources, budget planning. 271 events of Chhalfal Chautari on various social issue such as climate change, socio-economic package, GBV, Untouchability, and many more are conducted at EDC. PAHUCH coverage area Shikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM at reporting periods. By the means of

Chhalfal Chautari 1027 women member of 40 groups of both PAHUCH coverage area orient on different burning issue of our community. By the means of it

Srijan sil women group member Sardha BK got marriage registration after aware from Chhal phal Chautari group.

Asha BK of women member of Sikhar 8 and kabita Bohara of Sikhar 5 group member nominated as palika level women network from women group after capacitate in Chhal pahal Chautari.

- Out of 1027 of different women group 186 women member brief about racial discrimination and its legal provision and tolds to other.
- Out of 1027 of different women group 295 women member brief about gender based violence and its legal provision, and tolds to other and got action on it.

- Out of 1027 of different women group 370 women member brief about Chaupadhi system and its legal provision, and stay on safe place at the time of mensuration.
- Out of 1027 of different women group 160 women member brief about child marriage and its legal provision, and tolds to other and got action on it.
- Out of 1027 of different women group 250 women member brief about climate change adapation and its mitigation measure.
- Out of 1027 of different women group 86 women member brief about seven steps planning process of local level and commitement to address their own identify project at up coming settlements plannning process.
- Out of 1027 of different women group 135 women member brief about importance of vital registration,citizenship and its reeciving process.
- Out of 1027 of different women group women member 21 dalit male 31 dalit female child got birth certficate after sensitisation on Chhal phal Chautari abouts its importance .
- 22 Dalit women and 4 other women got marriage registration at these reporting periods after know its importance on Chhal phal Chautari.
- 18 Dalit women and 1 other women got citizeship certficate at these reporting period to know importance of it.
- 4 Dalit women of different women group reecive single allowance at these reporting periods.
- 49 dalit male child 39 female dalit child of different women group member reecive child nutration allowance at these periods.
- 18 women of different women group of project area got joint land certificate after know the importance of it at Chhalphal Chautari.
- Out of 1027 ,171 of different women member got representation on different comitee formed by LGs ,coopertaives and different Ngos at these reporting periods.
- Out of 1027 , 50 women got leadership at different comitee formed by LGs ,cooperative and different Ngo at these reporting periods.
- 150 women of different women group taking leadership to submit their own project at settlement level planning process at this year. After discuss on chhal phal Chautari

57 member of both palika engaged on primeminister employment scheme of palika wards.

In these reporting period basis on discuss on theme of Chhalphal Chautari both palika 15 women member got public service ..

Srijan sil women group member Sardha BK got marriage registration after aware from Chhal phal Chautari group.

20 Dalit women and 5 other women of PAHUCH coverage area got nominated as member at local level school management , forest user comitee and health management comitee after orient at Chhal pahal Chautari.

1.5 Exposure visit to the sites of climate resilient farming and green enterprises (Bardiya, Kailali, Doti and Kanchnapur Districts).

EDC PAHUCH team including climate champion visit on the climate smart village of LI Bird Kailali Joshipur area including DWRF climate friendly smart village Gauriganga 10 Udasipur and NNSWA Kanchanpur climate friendly agriculture area . In all area team observe about agriculture women group including climate friendly agriculture system such as different vegetable garden including vermi compost biogas and different product production by multipurpose cooperatives and also observe seed bank and brief detail about it .Finally saw management of agriculture cooperatives and its mobilization approach.

Participants understood about the basic concept of climate friendly agro ecology and its mitigation measure at local level and concern its issue and know about its importance. After observation of climate smart village including green enterprises area they have well knowledge about its detail process and also apply role model at their own working area. Five staff including 9 climate champion of both area of PAHUCH coverage area KI Singh RM and Shikhar Municipality took part at these events. Exposure create much learning environment them about climate friendly scheme.

1.6.2: Lobby/advocacy and support on formulate climate change policy and guideline to Palika
EDC PAHUCH team organise 1 days interaction programme about support and formulate climate change policy advocacy at KI Singh RM and Shikhar Municipality at the reporting. President of KI Singh Mr Lokendra B Shahi said it was important sector palika and different Ngos and other stakeholders done jointly efforts to formulate climate change policy at LGs .Shikhar Municipality vice presidents Mrs Sunita Jora said it was necessary for us to run palika budget and policy on climate change sector.

Output 2: Improved access to resources and information-including women entrepreneurship

2.1.4: Training on 7 steps budget planning and formulation of community Action Plan- 4 days

One training were completed on reporting periods participation of 33 women member of EDC PAHUCH coverage palika Sikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM. The training contribute enhance knowledge and understanding of participants to brief and discuss on seven steps budget and planning process. Sita Bhul women group member of KI Singh RM 3 said participatory planning process training was fruit ful for us first we understood its important steps third steps settlements level planning process which was at Baisakh 1st week we submit our community demands project at that time

- 33 women member of EDC PAHUCH coverage palika Sikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM informed about PPP.
- They inform about its importance step 3rd settlements level planning process.
- 40 women group of PAHUCH area submit their community action plan to their own wards.
- Budget and project should not flash out at the reporting periods of palika.
- Two CAP of Masta Mahila Samuha and Latha Kaphili Samhua rs passed 50000 from wardsno 7 ofice of Shikhar Munciality
- One CAP Of KI Singh RM Srijan sil Women group KI Singh 3 Public path Rs 250000 from KI Singh 3 Wards ofice.

2.2: Interaction/ Meetings with Judicial Committees and other stakeholders at local level on women's access to justice' in terms of GBV, access to local resources ,etc.

Two interaction meetings with Judicial committees and other stakeholders at local level on women's access to justice' in terms of GBV, access to local resources , were completed at reporting periods at KI Singh RM and Sikhar Municipality. 50 Participants from different palika level stakeholders took part at interaction.

- LGs represent of both palika commitment to minimize GBV cases on local area.
- The meeting focused on palika level judicial committee working process and equitable access of marginalised Dalit women.
- Judicial committee member of KI Singh 4 Mr Jaya B Dhami commitment to easily access to Dalit and marginalised women GBV survivor at own palika.
- It helps to increase GBV cases on palika judicial committee form Dalit and marginalised women from upcoming moments.

2.4: Multi-stakeholder Platform at Palika Level- Interaction with line agencies, stakeholders and service providers.

Two Multistakeholders platform meeting with palika level stakeholders were completed at reportings periods at KI Singh RM and Shikhar Municipality . 54 Participants on both palika from stake holder participants on meeting. The meeting was focus on different thematic result area of PAHUCH conducted activities and sharing progress from palika level thematic unit and it create mutual coordination and collaboration between both palika and projects . Shikhar Municipality Mayor Mr Dirgha B Balyar said these kinds of events create making accountable to line agencies ,stakeholders and service providers towards target community. These kinds of intervention always welcome from palika side. In upcoming days EDC design integrated types of project including advocacy and livelihood which was relief for dalit and vulnerable.

2.8.1 Training on entrepreneurship and business development to women entrepreneurs-5 days (FEDO) & 3 days _EDC

One training were completed on reporting periods participation of 25 women member of EDC PAHUCH covergae palika Sikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM. The training contribute enhance knowledge and understanding of participants to brief and discuss on women entrepreneurship and income generation among Dalit and marginalized women at local level for access to economic opportunities at local level. It helps to develop local small business scheme of local women smoothly conduct gaining knowledge of business plan including loan and business selection and demands of local market. Usha Bohara participants of training said it helps to increase knowledge on local business and entrepreneurship to rural women and heartily memorize when we bought loan for business all money used on that purpose it may way forwards of success.

- Working area trained women confident to do entrepreneurship at local level.
- 5 Dalit women member was selected by group or wards decision for token support.
- Shel Dhapu women group wards no 9 Asha BK start up business to start up 60 local chickens. After six months she got 50000 thousands profit
- Lila Koli of Shikhar get start poultry form and now she got 100000 one lakhs.
- Sita Tamrakar of Shikhar doing her tailoring and after support she have got 40 forty thousands from her tailoring shop.
- Alina Bhul of KI Singh RM well incoming after organization support 20000 in sewing shop. After earning from sewing she invests her son and daughter fees and stationary at school and also expands on house hold works.

2.8.2: Provide Business start-up support to women entrepreneurs:

Eighteen women local level entrepreneurship member priority to the single and dalit women of EDC PAHUCH coverage area Shikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM was supported at reporting period. Every four member got 20000 thousands per head for support on their conducted business uplift its status at local level. Out 18 seven carry out goat and rearing them to increase economics status. 5 out of 18 run small scale shop. 6 of them start up local chicken, poultry farming and small cosmetics shop and sewing shop- Two of them was support on sewing shop and one of them in poultry farm and Support helps to me relief conduct sewing shop smoothly said multimariage suffering person Mrs Sita Tamrakar she was isolated from her husbands.

2.9.1: Conduct training on social accountability targeting the LG stakeholders (social accountability tools)-1 days

One training were completed at reporting periods participation of 26 women member of EDC PAHUCH coverage palika Shikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM. The training contribute enhance knowledge skill and understanding of participants to brief and discuss on importance of social accountability and its basic tools such as public hearing, social audit, citizen charter and public audit. Women group member the training participants commitment to apply basic tool on individual group level and also suggests to LGs unit wards these things. Social accountability tools create responsible to both service provider and receiver.

Output 3: Improved Digital Literacy among Women and Dalits

3.1.2: Training to group members and project staff (Including Champaign and Frontline leaders)-3 days

One training were completed at reporting periods participation of 26 women member including 10 dalit women and 13 other women member of EDC PAHUCH coverage palika Shikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM. The training contribute enhance knowledge skill and understanding of participants to brief and discuss on importance of digital literacy and also about the basic concept of digital literacy and other right base issue and know about its importance. They knew about its importance its contents application process at local level. Participants know about basic tactful skill and tools and technique related digital literacy and its effectiveness at community level. Janki Balayar local women group digital literacy training was boon me like rural women about social media law including its benefits and its usefulness at local level.

3.1.6: Orientation on social medias and awaring its positive and negative consequences.

After orientation on Chhalphal Chautari about digital literacy 290 women of different group receive knowledge on digital literacy including different social media.

155 women member of coverage area open new Face book ID which easily helps them to connect their own relative husband son at India to cheaper rate for speak.

- KI Singh RM 3 Srijansil women group member Basanti BK know about its benefits she posted her goat photo an price after that she easily sold it in their own home. After that she also brief other group member about its benefits.
- 60 women of coverage area know about data pack which was easy to them long hours talk time to their member at India after orientation.
- 12 member of KI Singh brief to other about digital literacy.

- 289 member of different group put recharge cards after orientation.
- 192 member of coverage area open own named bank account at these periods.

3.2 Interaction/Orientation to Sensitise LG institution and community people for equal digital literacy to women.

This activity will focus to LGUs institutions for benefiting of targets Women. There will conduct the LGUs level interaction and orientation. Two interaction to sensitise Two interaction to sensitise LG institution and community people for equal digital literacy to women were completed at reporting periods at KI Singh RM and Sikhar Municipality .45 Participants from different palika level stakeholders and group member took part at interaction .The interaction focused on importance of digital literacy on present context and its implications status at local level .LG and helping agency coordinate toward this issue at local level.LG and helping agency coordinate to aware this issue at local level .Palika have fully support to awareness these issue said KI Singh RM presidents Mr Lokendra b Shahi .

3.3.3: Dialogue with Major Political Parties at Palika Level

Two dialogue with major political parties at palika level were completed on reporting periods participation of 55 member including palika chief of active political parties of district including media person and public representative took part of EDC PAHUCH coverage palika Sikhar Municipality and KI Singh RM. The interaction dialogue focused on positive and negative impacts of digital materials including internet. It contribute enhance knowledge and understanding of participants to brief and discuss on proper used of social media and internet and awareness provide from policy level to common people. Sunita Rawal jora participants of dialogue and vice Mayor of Shikahr Municipality. Said , It effects badly to marginalised women of our area ,unknown person contact in social media making false relation to them and create different cyber crime such as illegal sex relation ,multimarriage ,early marriage , using them at pronography or other bad activities . So it helps to increase awareness knowledge on grassroot level women which might be minimizing such event at upcoming moments.

Output 4: Advocacy efforts to end caste and gender discrimination and promote political leadership enhanced

4.1: Conduct Interaction on Legal provision with groups members and Judicial Committees on women's access to justice' and ending caste and gender-based violence and untouchability

Two interaction on legal provision with group members and judicial committees on women access to justice and ending caste and gender based violence and untouchability at palika level were completed at reporting periods participation of 29 people including palika official ,public representative and women group member of EDC PAHUCH coverage area Shikhar and KI Singh women group leader took participants on these events.It helps to increasing women access to justice and ending caste and gender based violence and untouchability at local level. Mina Bist one of the participants Vice Chair person of KI Singh RM brief those types of interaction helps such kinds of bad evil minimize. In upcoming moments on planned to organization and palika on joint venture to start such type of awareness campaign at local level which helps to reduce such issue at local level. These kind of collective effort help to reduce such tasks.

4.3: Organize orientation to Men and women youth to ending gender-based violence and Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) -1 days.

One orientation to men and women youth to ending gender based violence to intimate partner violence were completed on reporting periods participation of 15 women member

and their husbands of EDC PAHUCH coverage palika KI Singh RM. CASE STUDY

Salita succeed to got Citizenship certificate after effort of Women group

Salita DeviSarki is a Dalit women belong to Siskhar Municipality 10 Bادهkhola Doti. She is an active member of Pragatisil Mahila Samuha Chhal Phal Chautari too. She was married 20 years ago in early sixteen age an arranged marriage with Dhan Bahadur Sarki . They have 2 sons- and 1 daughter 9 and 10 and 3 years.



After marriage her husband going to India to earn and comes yearly and half yearly in festive time and also sessional cultivation. Her husband and family support at every moments. After 10 years ago her husband was not return back from India with out of totally contact from own relative including villagers . She goes to India different time from searching him but not found. She works on village as a labourer work to conduct household activities including her daughter and son school expenses .She expand single life in a village and also was not go or speak on infront of mass .She feel shy to introduce. When EDC PAHUCH project launched at Shikhar Municipality 10 Bادهkhola . She was to take partcipate at role of group member at Pragatisil Mahila Samuha women group. In group she actively partcipants on diffrent event conducted by projects such as ChalPhal Chautari ,group meeting diffrent intreaction disscussion on group meeting or Chalphal Chautari such as Mass awareness Campaign of caste base discrimination gender based violence and importance of vital registration including citizenship certificate and its importance in the mean of group she have going to delication on the wards office . In 1st time wards office refused to reecive citizenship because her husband was not the proof of death certificate either he was alive in India. Due to absence of citizenship she face different problem such as not to recive nutratrion allowance and different service froom wards and other stakeholders. After it she brief her problem on Chhal Phal Chautari .All the member of Pragatisil women member goes to wards and did advocacy to them citizenship to convey president and and employee of wards office. After that they reecive citizenship and devlop speaking skill and confidence on public concern .After that she was nominated as treasurer on community water mangement comitte and she also open bank account for goat gift support by DCA Nepal also reecive 4 goats which was very good for conduct livelihood Now she was developed as a role model activist on group as a sector of caste and GBV sector and actively partcipants on community work .

Finally she thanks PAHUCH EDC formation group and Chalphal Chautari empowered me as grassroot level women to wards level community activists representative.

Case Story

Basanti BK was the residence of KI Singh RM 3 Ghija Basti. She has two sons and one daughter including husbands. Her husbands was on India .She was busy on household activities at agriculture work including goat rearing scheme .She have 5 she goat and 3 he goat on her home .She was engaged rearing goat.in village but she have not professional idea including tradational selling methods. When she and her family have demand of money they have not sold her goats easily due market acess on far place .

Two years ago when she unite women group under PAHUCH projects, she was actively partrcipants on Chhal phal Chautari including different projects intervention especially orientation and importance of digital literacy. In previous day she was not able to speak new person at village especially male person. After capactrizing at Chhal Phal Chautari she learn different things such as importance of digital literacy such opening face book id install mesenger and call with their husband at chief rate. After literate on it she took photo of her goat with contact no and rate on face book wall she posted .After two days a man come with rate in her own house and she sold goat on her own house .It help to save time and money and easily sold item. Finally she gave thanks for EDC PAHUCH team which capactize me orient as digital media which was unforgetable events at my life .Now she was devloped as campaigner women at community and also orient about digital literacy on group and community.
